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

SBBU SIGNS MOUS WITH TURKISH UNIVERSITIES

haheed Benazir Bhutto University (SBBU) entered into Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), with twenty national and international universities on September 23 and 24, 2013 during the Second OIC VCs Conference arranged by COMSATS Institute of Information Technology (CIIT), in collaboration with Higher Education Commission (HEC), Ministry of Science and Technology and the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (ISESCO) at Serena Hotel, Islamabad. This list includes the following top class Turkish universities; Dicle University, Fatih University, Gediz University, Namik Kemal University, TR Erzincan University, Trakya Balkan University, Yildirim Beyazit University and Bozok University. The MoUs were signed by Prof. Dr. Khan Bahadar Marwat, Vice Chancellor, SBBU and the Rectors of respective Turkish universities.

These MoUs will pave a number of ways for collaboration of SBBU in the area of research, student exchange programmes, staff exchange and offering of dual degree programme, etc. Dr. KB Marwat expressed his opinion that there are a lot of opportunities for collaboration between SBBU and Turkish universities. The Rectors of Turkish universities also shared their views with the Vice-Chancellor and spoke on the procedures followed for admission of students for undergraduate and graduate programmes of their universities in Turkey and the scope for exchange programmes. The exchange programmes would start from early next year. At the end of the ceremony, the Vice Chancellor presented the honourable guests with university souvenirs. Prof. Bacha Hussain, Registrar, Dr. M. Kamal Khan, Director QEC, Mr. Siraj Muhammad, HOD (Computer Sciences), Mr. Javed Iqbal, HOD (Forestry) and Mr. Ijaz Hassan, AD P&D were also present on the occasion. They termed the MoUs as an achievement for bilateral cooperation between Shaheed Benazir Bhutto University and international HEIs.



PROTOCOL OF MEVLANA EXCHANGE PROGRAMME SIGNED



The protocol of Mevlana Exchange Programme was signed by Shaheed Benazir Bhutto University (SBBU) with two Turkish universities i.e., Erzincan University and Bozok University. 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SBBU PARTICIPATES IN TWO-DAY CONFERENCE ON UNIVERSITIES IN THE ISLAMIC WORLD: CHALLENGES OF INTERNATIONALISATION



SBBU participated in the two-day forum titled "Universities in the Islamic World: Challenges of Internationalisation" on September 23rd and 24th at Serena Hotel, Islamabad. The programme was inaugurated by State Minster for Education, Trainings and Standards in Higher Education Balighur Rehman and was also attended by Minister for Higher Education of Sudan and the head of the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (ISESCO). The forum was organised by

COMSATS Institute of Information Technology (CIIT), in collaboration with Higher Education Commission (HEC), Ministry of Science and Technology and ISESCO. Over 200 VCs of universities and higher education institutes of Muslim states participated in the event. CIIT Rector Dr. SM Junaid Zaidi and HEC Executive Director Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed spoke to the inauguration ceremony of the conference. The plenary talk was undertaken by former HEC Chairperson Prof. Dr. Attaur

Through this opportunity SBBU got introduced to national and international level organizations. 

NEED BASED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME (NBSP) AT SHAHEED BENAZIR BHUTTO UNIVERSITY



The Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan recently launched the Need Based Scholarship Program (NBSP) at Shaheed BB University. This programme aims to elevate the socio-economic position of the needy & deserving students by providing access to quality education through needs-based scholarships. According to the national income statistics(by GOP), 80 % of the families in Pakistan cannot afford the expenses of sending even one boarder to a local public university. The main objectives of the programme are:

- 1. To provide an opportunity for talented students who are financially disadvantaged and are incapable of meeting higher education costs.
- 2. To provide opportunities for academically qualified, yet financially needy, students to continue university studies, especially from remote and rural areas of FATA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- 3. To enhance the institutional capacity of universities in designing and implementing need and merit based scholarship projects.
- 4. To provide special opportunity to the needy female students of rural areas to continue their higher education.

For the said program, the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Jehandar Shah nominated Dr. Muhammad Kamal

Khan as the Focal Person at SBBU. He designed the program and called for applications from deserving students in April. On the recommendations of HEC and VC, the Institutional Scholarship Award Committee (ISAC) was framed who conducted the interviews of 132 students on June 11, 2013 under the yardsticks of HEC. The interviews were presided by the

Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Jehandar Shah. Two eminent scholars, two community members and Higher Education Commission representative were also present in the interviews. Finally 19 scholarships were awarded to the most deserving candidates of Shaheed Benazir Bhutto University.
